Organizing authority

TYF Warm Up Regatta is organized by Turkish Sailing Federation and Goztepe Sailing Club on 16 – 19 July 2023.

420 Classes

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be goverened by the "rules" as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) (2021-2024), the applicable Class Rules and this Notice of Race and Additional Sailing Instructions to be published.
- 1.2. No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3. RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will apply;
- 1.4. In all rules governing this championship:
- 1.5. Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official. Reasonable actions by event officials to implement COVID 19 guidance, protocols, or legislation, even if they later prove to have been unnecessary, are not improper actions or omissions.





1.6. English is the Official Language of the Championship. If there is a conflict between languages the language of the original version of the relevant document will take precedence.

2. NOTICE TO THE COMPETITORS

2.1. All notices to competitors (Organization Committee, Race Committee and Jury) will be posted at the event website.

3. ADVERTISING[NP][DP]

3.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1 Competitors shall comply with World Sailing Eligibility Code (Regulation 19);
- 4.2 Entries should be received by the Organizing Authority no later than 15 July 2023;
- 4.3Competitors can register and pay the entry fee by visiting at www.warmupregatta.com

5 ENTRY

5.1 Entries shall be made by completing the relevant online registration forms found on the www.warmupregatta.com website and by paying the required fees according to the following schedule:





- 5.2 Payment instructions, including banking information, can be found on the PAYMENT page of the online entry system at www.420warmupregatta.com website.
- 5.3 Entry fee per boat is 100 Euros.
- 5.4 Late Entry Fee Surcharge 20 Euros after 09 July 2023.
- 5.5 Final registrations at the venue Goztepe Sailing Club should be made by on Sunday, 16 July 2023 at 17.00 by Race Secretary.
- 5.6 The organizing authority will cancel event/ class if the entry numbers has been less than 15 boats.

6 FORMAT OF THE REGATTA

- 6.1 The Championships is scheduled to be completed as single series, with 6 races. At Least 3 races are required completed to constitute the regatta series;
- 6.2 The number of fleets will be defined as below:
 - One fleet up to 50 boats
 - Two fleets from 51 to 100 boats
 - Three fleets for more than 100 boats

The number of fleets may be changed by the Organizing Authority

6.3 Final format will be described at the Sailing Instructions





7. PROGRAM

- 7.1. A total of 6 races are scheduled, with a maximum of 3 races per day.
- 7.2. No warning signal will be given after 17.00 on Wednesday 19 July.
- 7.3. Prize giving will be as soon as possible after the Last Race of the day.

8. MEASUREMENT[DP]

- 8.1. All competitors shall comply with the Class Rules. Boats may be checked at any time on shore and on the water.
- 8.2. Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved in writing by the Technical Committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race Committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

9.1. Sailing Instructions will be published on the event website.

11. THE COURSE

Courses will be Olympic trapezoid or windward/leeward at Racing Areas – see ATTACHMENT A.

12. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 12.1. Appendix P will apply for the Fleet races.
- 12.2. Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

13. SCORING

13.1. Low-point system of RRS App A will be applied.

14. SUPPORT BOATS[NP][DP]

- 14.1. All Support boats shall be registered during registration day with the Organizing Authority.
- 14.2. All support boats shall clearly display the 3-letter national code of their WS Member National Authority at all times while afloat. The minimum height for the letters shall be 200mm;
- 14.3. During the registration support boats will received numeral sticker that will identify the coach boat





15. BOAT PARKING

15.1. Boats shall not park outside their allocated places.

16. PRIZES

16.1. Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in each class

17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 17.1. Competitors and support team members participate in the series entirely at their own risk and they are reminded of the provisions of RRS 3, Decision to Race. Sailing is, by its nature, an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor and the responsible adult agrees and acknowledges that:
- 17.2. They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- 17.3. They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- 17.4. They accept responsibility for any injury damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omission;
- 17.5. Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event, and they are fit to participate;





- 17.6. The Organising Authority and any other party involved in the organization of the Championship will accept no liability whatsoever for any injury, damage, loss or claim, whether personal or material, incurred by or inflicted to competitors before, during or after the Regatta.
 - 17.7 By participating in this regatta, a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the Event Sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show at their discretion any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the regatta, and of all of his or her material related to the regatta, without compensation.

18. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall have valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of at least EUR 1.500.000,00 (or equivalent) per incident.
